





Santa Clara Church





If you're seeking something of the beaten path, Porto has plenty of hidden treasures waiting to be discovered. From quiet streets with colorful street art to charming coffee shops tucked in secret corners, Porto's lesser-known spots are just as captivating as its famous landmarks.



■ Casa São Roque (Park and Art Centre)

Famous for its labyrinth, it is a great location for a stroll and relaxation.

■ Passeio Alegre Garden

Huge palm trees that stretch out along the street. A place where the river meets the sea, in a peaceful atmosphere, along with the lighthouses and small boats on the river.

■ Sunset on the Beach Terraces in Foz

End your day with a magical sunset at one of the delightful beachside terraces in Foz, the perfect spot to relax and reflect on your Porto adventure.



■ Viewpoint of Santa Catarina and Senhora dos Anjos Chapel

A hidden viewpoint offering stunning views over the sea.

■ Águas do Porto Park

(Garden and Sculptures)
Notable for its panoramic view over the river, as well as for its tranquility and heritage (fountains and water features).



Walking along the River and Seafront

Take a scenic walk from Ribeira to Foz, where you can admire the picturesque streets, the colorful clothes drying on balconies, and the old fishing area of Cantareira. Alternatively, hop on the charming tramway from Ribeira to Passeio Alegre (Foz) for a nostalgic journey along the coastline.

The history of pharmacy through rare artifacts and fascinating exhibits, tracing its evolution across different eras at Porto's Pharmacy Museum.




Nossa Senhora da Conceição Church and Tower


